The Bible Story: Moses's Farewell

BIBLE POINTS

TELL THE BIBLE STORY (5 minutes)

SIT DOWN with your children and share a snack together.

Provide a bible for your baby to hold and open. Open your Bible to Deuteronomy 31-34. <u>Click here to show the Bible story picture</u> on page 4 as you say the BIBLE POINTS in a soothing voice.

Say - Moses led God's people to the promised land. Jesus is greater than Moses because He rescues us. WE CAN TRUST GOD WITH ALL OUR HEARTS.

The Israelites walked in the wilderness for 40 years. Moses was very old, and he had a message for the people. Moses said, "I cannot go into the promised land. The Lord will go before you, and God chose Joshua to lead you. God will not leave you." Then Moses wrote down God's rules. Moses told the people to be careful to obey God's words and teach them to their children. "These words are your life," Moses said. Moses blessed all of the tribes of Israel, and he praised God. Then God took Moses to the top of the mountain so he could see the beautiful land that God had promised His people. Then Moses died, and God buried him.

EXPERIENCE & APPLY THE STORY

OPTION 1:

OPTION 1: Play with People figures (Little People, Legos People, Duplo People, figurines or stuffed animals...be creative)

Fold sheets of scrap paper in half and stand them up to be "tents." Provide peg people or other people and animal figures for toddlers to play out the Israelite camp. As toddlers play, retell the Bible story. You could even video them telling the story and share it with Kristin Sullivan.

SAY: Moses led God's people to the promised land. Moses reminded God's people to love and obey God when they left their tents and entered the promised land. WE CAN TRUST GOD.

OPTION 2: Climb a mountain (pillows, blanket)

Pile a few throw pillows on the floor and cover them with a blanket. Assist toddlers as they climb the "mountain" one at a time. Briefly retell the Bible story.

SAY: Moses led God's people to the promised land. Jesus is greater than Moses because He rescues us. WE CAN TRUST GOD because He sent Jesus.

OPTION 3: Create a Bible story scene (blocks, fabric)


Guide children to build a mountain shape with interlocking blocks. Add a male plastic figure to the top of the shape to represent Moses. Wrap a small piece of fabric around the figure to create the look of Bible times clothing.

SAY: Moses reminded the people of God's promise. The time had come for God's people to go into the promised land. Moses went up to the top of a mountain where he could see the promised land.



OPTION 4: Coloring Page (crayons, markers)

Have your child use crayons or markers to color the sheet on the next page.
